In commemoration of the new TOMICA Happy Meal that will be released on Friday, April 12, 2024, the three companies of McDonald's Company (Japan), Ltd. (Representative Director, President and CEO: Tamotsu Hiiro, headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter McDonald's), TOYOTA GAZOO Racing (hereinafter TGR), and TOMY Company, Ltd. (Representative Director, President & COO: Kazuhiro Kojima, headquarters: Katsushika-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter TOMY Company) will collaborate to launch the special TOMICA Happy Meal Project from Thursday, April 4, 2024. This year marks 10 years since the release of the first TOMICA Happy Meal. The anniversary will be celebrated in style through this project.







Reflecting the shared wish of the three companies to "support children's dreams," this special project brings together the McDonald's principles of "delivering that signature McDonald's FUN" and "bolstering the happiness of families by supporting the growth and development of children" with TGR's desires "to share the 'dreams' and 'inspiration' of cars to customers" and "that cars will continue to make children's hearts flutter for another 100 years," as well as TOMY Company's wish to "nurture children's creativity, learn about the workings of society, and deepen the bonds between parents and children" through TOMICA.

In first round of this project, the special video "DRIFT Twins" will be released on Thursday, April 4, prior to the launch of the TOMICA Happy Meal on Friday, April 12. The video depicts a child playing with his Happy Meal original Toyota GR Corolla toys through a world created by his imagination. The video features Kalle Rovanperä and Ken Gushi, two stars of the TOYOTA GAZOO Racing World Rally Team, getting into cars specially made for this collaboration and delivering a precisely coordinated drift performance. Not only has Rovanperä distinguished himself as the youngest FIA World Rally Champion in history, he has even gone on to win back-to-back titles. At age 16, Gushi became the then-youngest competitor in the D1 Grand Prix and Formula Drift Championships, and has continued to lead the world of drifting both in Japan and overseas to the present day.

Furthermore, in second round of the project, starting on the same day of Thursday, April 4 the McDonald's Harumi-Dori Toyosu restaurant (location: Koto-ku, Tokyo) will be transformed into the Flagship Restaurant of the collaboration between the three companies of McDonald's, TGR and TOMY Company, featuring a variety of limited-time actions.
